Subject: EHR Incentive Program

Did you know that health care providers can receive thousands of dollars in incentives simply by adopting certified Electronic Health Records (EHR)? Incentive payments up to **\$63,750** through the Medicaid incentive program and **\$44,000** through the Medicare program can be made to eligible professionals.

Who is Eligible to Receive the Incentive?

- Providers must be a Medicaid professional (fee-for-service or managed care)
- 30% of the provider's practice must be Medicaid patients
- Providers cannot be hospital based, or provide 90% or more of their services in a hospital setting

Goals for Incentives

Providers must demonstrate that the EHR is being used to improve quality, increase efficiency and promote patient safety.

These health care goals should be demonstrated: improving quality, safety, efficiency; reducing health disparities; engaging patients and their families; ensuring security protections for protected health information; improving public health.
