Diagnosis Codes (ICD-10-CM)

Effective Date: October 1, 2021

Summary

Effective Oct. 1, 2021 the Ohio Department of Medicaid updated its claims payment system to reflect the annual International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision, Diagnosis Code (ICD-10-CM). Updates are made effective October 1 of each year. The 2022 edition contains 191 additions and 45 code revisions (descriptions updated or diagnosis codes changed to headers).

Impact

The 2022 ICD-10-CM files below contain information on the ICD-10-CM updates for FY 2022. These 2022 ICD-10-CM codes are to be used for discharges occurring from Oct. 1, 2021 through Sept. 30, 2022 and for patient encounters occurring from Oct. 1, 2021 through Sept. 30, 2022. The Medicaid managed care plans should be contacted for information concerning their specific claim submission requirements.

Importance

There is no FY 2022 GEMs file. As stated in the FY 2016 IPPS/LTCH PPS final rule (80 FR 49388), the GEMs have been updated on an annual basis as part of the ICD-10 Coordination and Maintenance Committee meetings process and will continue to be updated for approximately 3 years after ICD-10 is implemented.
