**Subject:** Provision of Family Centered Treatment and Waiver Services

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## Summary

Family Centered Treatment® (FCT) is a comprehensive, evidence-based, trauma treatment model of intensive in-home services (IIHS) for children, adolescents and families at risk for out-of-home placement. FCT is a preventative, stabilization and reunification service designed to address family functioning and multi-generational trauma. It is a researched, viable alternative to residential placements, hospitalization, correctional facility placement and other community-based services.

During the provision of Family-Centered Treatment (FCT) services (H0037), it is important to note that no other home and community-based services can be provided. This policy is in place to ensure that members receive focused and effective care during their FCT sessions.

However, services outlined in the Counseling and Crisis Provider Manual may continue if they are deemed medically necessary. Providers are encouraged to assess the individual needs of their members and coordinate care accordingly, ensuring that any continuation of services aligns with the guidelines set forth in the Counseling and Crisis Provider Manual.
