

## What is coverage that cares?

At CCA, our health plan is designed around you. We place you with a **personal care coordinator**, who connects you to a wide range of support in your community, including local doctors to help you navigate the healthcare system.

And this personalized, connected care is provided at no cost to you.

### Enrollment criteria

1. You're 65 or older.
2. You're entitled to Medicare Part A (hospital insurance), are enrolled in Medicare Part B (medical insurance) and enrolled in MassHealth Standard.
3. You do not have any other comprehensive health insurance besides Medicare.
4. You live in one of the following counties: Bristol, Essex, Franklin, Hampden, Hampshire, Middlesex, Norfolk, Plymouth, Suffolk, or Worcester.

Enrollment in the plan depends on the plan's contract renewal with Medicare. This plan is a voluntary program that is available to anyone 65 and older who qualifies for MassHealth Standard and Original Medicare and does not have any other comprehensive health insurance, except Medicare.

For members with certain active, chronic conditions

You can spend your **\$420** quarterly allowance on utilities and plan-covered food<sup>3</sup>.

You may also qualify for **10** non-emergent, non-medical rides per month<sup>3</sup> (50-mile radius).
