The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the American Medical Association (AMA) released a frequently asked questions-and-answers (FAQ) document to clarify a joint statement issued in July to help physicians prepare for the International Classification of Diseases, 10<sup>th</sup> Revision (ICD-10), code set transition on Oct. 1, 2015.
