CareSource is monitoring drug shortages and ongoing global supply issues affecting oncology medications and their use in cancer treatment regimens. We are in contact with our oncology regimen review partner, NantHealth, who is aware of the shortage, following it closely, and handling issues on a case-by-case basis.

NantHealth updated their Eviti Provider Portal, instructing providers to alert NantHealth if they are substituting based on a shortage. All substitutions must be supported by guidelines and evidence-based resources. Please see NantHealth's alert to providers below:

- **Attention Providers:** With the current drug shortages leading to impacts with certain chemotherapy drugs, we understand that there may be a change in your treatment plan ordering. If the current chemotherapy drug shortage impacts the treatment plan you are entering into the Eviti platform, please note that within your supporting documents. This will aid in fewer calls from the Eviti team to the submitter for clarification and thus help eliminate any recommendation delays.
