Subject: Expired License/Certification and Provider Enrollment

As general conditions of participation, all enrolled providers must:

- Be fully licensed without restriction and certified under all applicable and federal laws to perform the services in the applicable category of service
- Maintain current (non-delinquent) licenses and certifications required for the provision of such services
- Inform the Georgia Medicaid Management Information System (GAMMIS) in writing immediately upon the expiration, suspension, probation, limitation, or revocation of any such license or certification

Medical residents may enroll as prescribing physicians using their Residency Training Permit (RTP) only for the purpose of prescribing outpatient prescription medications.

To ensure all providers are fully licensed, Georgia Medicaid sends license/certification expiration reminder letters <90 days> prior to the license/certification expiring with detailed instructions outlining the process to update the enrollment file with the most current license/certification.

If the license/certification isn't submitted, the enrollment file is suspended the day after the license/certification expiration date. A suspension letter is also issued with detailed instructions outlining the process to update the enrollment file with the most current license/certification during the suspension period.

If the license/certification isn't submitted during the suspension period, the enrollment file will be terminated <30 days> from the date the file is suspended and a new enrollment application must be submitted for re-enrollment; retro-enrollment cannot be requested.
