

Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT)

EPSDT covers care for those under the age of 21 at no cost to you. Your child's PCP will work with you to make sure your child gets the needed care. EPSDT includes:


- Well-child exams
- Vision and hearing tests
- Health education
- Lab testing
- Lead screening

EPSDT also covers medically necessary care for issues found by an exam. This could be glasses or hearing aids. There are Care Management services for members under the age of 21 with special health care needs. Call us at **1-855-202-0729** (TTY: 711) and ask for Care Management.

To stay with CareSource, you need to renew with Georgia Division of Family and Children Services (DFCS) office every year. If you don't, you can lose your Medicaid eligibility for health care coverage. DFCS will mail you information when you need to do this.

Renew in One of These Ways:

Online. Go to the Georgia Gateway, sign in and renew your benefits.

By Phone. Call 1-877-423-4746. Business hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday.

By Mail. Fill out the form and mail it back right away to DFCS. Visit dfcs.georgia.gov/locations.

In Person. Visit your local county DFCS office. Visit dfcs.georgia.gov/locations.
