Dear Caregiver:

Happy New Year! Each year babies, children, and teens should visit their doctor for a **Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT)** exam(s) as a part of their well child visit schedule. The **EPSDT** is used to find and treat health problems early. If the doctor thinks there might be a health problem, more tests and care may be needed.

EPSDT exams are free. These exams cover:

- Review of your child's health since birth
- Full exam (with parent's okay)
- Exam to make sure your child's skills are right for his/her age
- Vision screening
- Dental exam
- Hearing screening
- Check to make sure your child is up to date on shots
- Lead screening
- Other tests as needed

EPSDT exams should be done at:

- Birth
- 3 to 5 days after birth
- The following months of age: 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, 24, 30

After that, children and teens should have at least one exam per year.
