**Subject:** Reminder: Medicaid Requirements for Billing, Attending, Ordering, Referring, Rendering and Prescribing Providers

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### **Summary**

This is a reminder of CareSource's policy, in conjunction with [Georgia Department of Community Health \(DCH\) policy](#). DCH requires provider information be maintained and updated in the Georgia Medicaid Management Information System (GAMMIS).

### **Impact**

Any NPI or Medicaid ID reported on a claim must be reported to GAMMIS. Claims submitted to CareSource with non-credentialed NPIs (Billing, Attending, Ordering, Referring, Rendering and Prescribing) will be denied. You can enroll providers with DXC at:

### **Importance**

It is important for providers to understand the implications of failing to enroll in Medicaid. If you are a provider described above including physicians, other practitioners and facilities who render services to Medicaid beneficiaries, your claims will **not** be paid for such items or services unless you enroll in Medicaid and your National Provider Identifier (NPI) number is included on the claim submitted to CareSource by the rendering provider.
