How to Access the HAP CareSource MI Coordinated Health Clinical Practice Registry

Providers will need to register for the HAP CareSource Provider Portal to access the Clinical Practice Registry.

Our Provider Portal is free, secure and easy to use.

1. Visit **HAPCareSource.com** > Login > Provider and follow link to the HAP Provider Portal.
2. Enter your HAP username and password, then click the Log In button.
3. Select the HAP CareSource link on the home page to single sign-on (SSO) to the HAP CareSource Provider Portal. No registration or separate login is needed.
4. To ensure the security of your data, provide your multifactor authentication information.
5. Select the Member Reports menu on the left to locate the Clinical Practice Registry link. Click on Clinical Practice Registry to obtain access.
6. Select the appropriate primary care provider in the Providers drop-down menu. The patient data for the members attributed to the selected primary care provider (PCP) will display.
