The MAHP advocates the adoption and implementation of the MQIC Clinical Practice Guidelines as the accepted standards of care to promote quality care and better health outcomes for Michiganders. The consortium works to establish and update clinical practice guidelines for use by health care professionals and health plans. Guidelines are reviewed on a two-year cycle.
