Subject: Removal of Temporary Waiver for TPL for Telehealth Codes
Effective Date: July 20, 2025

Summary

Effective March 9, 2020, CareSource temporarily waived Third Party Liability (TPL) for the codes listed below. The temporary waiving is now being removed effective on July 20, 2025. It impacted claims for telehealth when a member's primary insurance is Medicare or commercial, given the differences in the procedure codes that are covered for telehealth and differences in means of delivery. The standard process involved Medicaid denial, and then the provider appealed the denial through a manual process. To avoid manual processing of these types of claims, the following system logic will be implemented on July 20, 2025:

Impact

1. Commercial/TPL – The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) processes TPL claims for payment when Medicare doesn't cover it. As a proxy for commercial coverage of telehealth, Medicaid is using Medicare telehealth coverage to develop a code group that reflects procedure codes that commercial insurance does not cover via telehealth. When Medicaid receives claims to pay as primary for one of these codes with GT modifier, TPL edits are bypassed.

2. Medicare – a new Medicare procedure code group will reflect procedure codes that Medicare does not cover via telehealth. Providers must include the GT modifier to indicate the procedure is covered by Medicare but is not covered when delivered through telehealth. When Medicaid receives a claim to pay as primary for one of these codes with GT modifier, Medicare edits are bypassed.

3. Medicare – Medicare has a limited number of procedure codes that can be rendered via telephone, whereas Medicaid has a substantial list of procedure codes. ODM is also allowing for texting and telephone delivery that Medicare only allows in very limited circumstances. A code group for these codes will be created, where the procedure code is Medicare-covered and eligible for telehealth but not covered when provided using audio-only means. ODM will allow for providers to include both the GT and GY modifiers with the procedure code. When Medicaid receives a claim with both modifiers, it will allow these claims to bypass system edits and allow them to process for payment.
