Summary

On July 31, 2025, the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services (MDHHS) ended its continued enrollment, or deeming, process for Medicaid redetermination. HAP CareSource MI Health Link members no longer have access to deeming/continued health plan enrollment while they work on the Medicaid redetermination.

Impact

Members have 60 days to complete their Medicaid redetermination renewal paperwork upon MDHHS notification. If they do not complete their Medicaid redetermination, they will lose their Medicaid eligibility and no longer be in the HAP CareSource MI Health Link plan. This period gave patients extra time to get their Medicaid paperwork filled out while keeping their HAP CareSource MI Health Link benefits and services.

Importance

Please encourage your patients to complete their Medicaid redetermination paperwork as soon as they are notified.

What If Your Patient Loses Medicaid Coverage?

If a member has not regained full Medicaid eligibility, they will no longer be enrolled in the HAP CareSource MI Health Link plan. We will send a letter to them explaining they are no longer enrolled. Individuals will receive their Medicare services through traditional Medicare, or they can choose a Medicare Advantage plan and a Medicare Part D plan. They will no longer be eligible to receive Medicaid services.
