

Tips for Successful Processing of Flu Vaccines

The following will help a physician or qualified non-physician health partner obtain a paid vaccine claim for our members:

1. Vaccines for Children Program – see list of appropriate codes below
2. For VFC and Adult immunizations, the vaccine AND the administration code(s) must be billed together
3. Admin Codes: 90460, 90461, 90471, 90472, 90473, 90474, G0008, G0009 and G0010

VACCINES FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The federal Vaccines for Children (VFC) program makes designated vaccines available at no cost to health partners to administer to children 18 and younger who are enrolled in Medicaid. CareSource members are eligible for these vaccines.

Please bill CareSource with the appropriate CPT and ICD-9 or ICD-10 vaccination codes if billing after 10/1/2015, for the immunization being administered. CareSource pays for the administration of the vaccine only. Please bill with the correct vaccine code to ensure proper reimbursement.

ICD-10 IMMUNIZATION CODES

Please bill CareSource with the following CPT and ICD-10 vaccination codes after 10/1/2015 to receive reimbursement for administration of the vaccine.
