Subject: HIP Maternity Benefits Reminder

Summary

CareSource would like to remind providers that Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP)-eligible pregnant women receive full State Plan benefits under HIP Maternity without cost-sharing obligations.

Impact

Women with HIP Maternity have access to all State Plan services and benefits, which is also described in the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) provider reference module, [Member Eligibility and Benefit Coverage](#).

HIP Maternity: This benefit plan offers access to all benefits available under the State Plan, with no cost-sharing, to pregnant women who are enrolled in or determined eligible for HIP. During the member's pregnancy and for a 60-day postpartum period, HIP Maternity offers enhanced benefits including vision, dental, and chiropractic services; nonemergency transportation; and enhanced smoking cessation services.

Importance

It's important to note HIP Maternity does not mimic Presumptive Eligibility for Pregnant Women (PEPW) or emergency services with coverage for pregnancy, which only covers emergent and pregnancy related services.
