This is an exciting time for you. You may be feeling nervous, anxious and relieved all at the same time. You are not alone in this. You have people who are rooting for your success.

CareSource is here to help.



CareSource has a special team in place to help you in your transition back to the community. One member of this team is the Community Justice Liaison (CJL). The CJL is here for you and can answer questions like:

- I have been released, now what?
- How can I get counseling or mental health services?
- How can I find out about my health care options?
- How can I find out about community resources for me?
- Who can help me find a job, enroll in job training or further my education?
- Where can I get support?

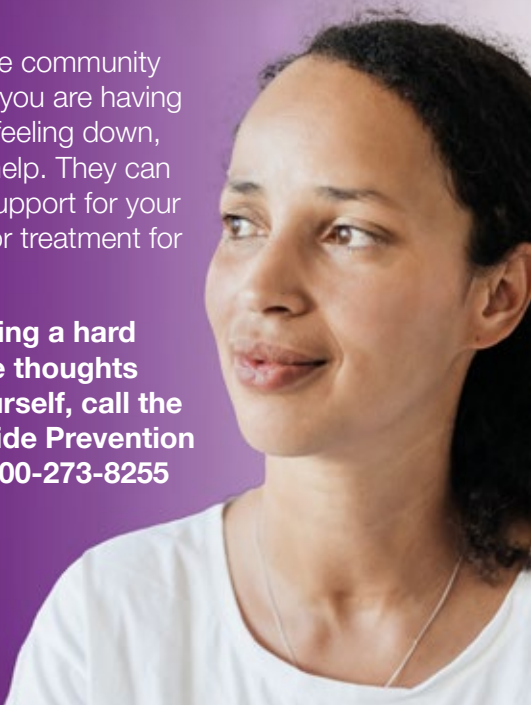
Our Team

Your CJL will work with you to create a plan and set goals for your first 90 days after release. They will connect you to health care and community resources during this transition. They will work with you to make sure that your Hoosier Healthwise (HHW) or Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) benefits are active. You will also have access to programs like CareSource JobConnect™ through your CareSource HHW or HIP plan.

Returning to the community can be hard. If you are having a hard time or feeling down, your CJL can help. They can help you find support for your mental health or treatment for substance use.

Expungement

CareSource will cover the cost of expungement (up to \$500) for eligible returning citizens. These returning citizens must:

- Not have *pending* charges in any state
- Pay all fines, fees, court costs and restitution (CareSource will help cover these costs with this fund)
- Wait the required time since the offense or conviction
- Be part of the CareSource Re-Entry Program or CareSource JobConnect through CareSource Life Services®
- Get a letter of approval from the prosecutor's office
