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Indiana Statewide Uniform Preferred Drug List (SUPDL) Provider Notice

Please be advised that the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is transitioning to a Statewide Uniform Preferred Drug List (SUPDL) for the fee-for-service (FFS) and managed care entities (MCEs). Beginning July 5, 2023, all MCEs will adopt the FFS preferred drug list (PDL), maintaining the same preferred and nonpreferred drug status, clinical criteria requirements, and format for prior authorization (PA) submission as the FFS program.

The SUPDL will include products in the drug classes listed in the FFS PDL. Members utilizing nonpreferred products will need to be transitioned to preferred products within 90 days of the July 5, 2023 implementation. If you feel it is medically necessary for the member to remain on a nonpreferred product, you will need to submit a prior authorization request.

Prior authorization criteria can be found under the Preferred Products tab on the <u>Optum Rx</u> <u>Indiana Medicaid website</u>, accessible from the <u>Pharmacy Services</u> page. Prior authorization forms can be found on the <u>Forms</u> page at **CareSource.com**.
