Re: Summary of PDL Changes Effective April 1, 2019

Dear Humana – CareSource Member:

Your health care is our priority. That is why we are writing to tell you that on 04/01/2019, Humana – CareSource will change its Preferred Drug List (PDL). A PDL is a list of preferred drugs.

THE FOLLOWING MEDICINES WILL BE NON-PREFERRED ON THE PDL EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2019.

However, all current users are expected to switch to a Steglatro or Segluromet by April 1, 2019
