Subject: FQHC and RHC Taxonomy Update

Humana – CareSource wants to make you aware of a delay in removing the taxonomy requirement for certain claims. This delay impacts the following providers:

- Certain Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC)
- Provider type 31/Rural Health Centers (RHC)
- Provider type 35 with an appropriate specialty code

Next Steps

To avoid payment delays, continue following the taxonomy billing standards in place since December 9, 2013. As a reminder, taxonomy is still required for rendering providers.

During the delay in implementing this change, you may need to resubmit claims under the following circumstances:

- If you submitted claims without taxonomy and received a rejection notice from Humana – CareSource, please resubmit the claim **with** taxonomy.
- If a rejected claim was submitted at the end of the timely filing range and cannot be resubmitted without timely filing denial, Humana – CareSource requests that you notify your Provider Engagement Representative. Your representative can request a timely filing waiver specific to Kentucky Department for Medicaid Services' PT31/35 taxonomy update. Humana – CareSource will waive timely filing claim processing edits for claims impacted by this implementation delay.
