| What is the overall deductible? | \$1,200 individual/\$2,400 family per Benefit Year | Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> . |
| Are there services covered before you meet your deductible? | Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> . | This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. |
| Are there other deductibles for specific services? | No | You don't have to meet <u>deductibles</u> for specific services. |
