Dear Humana – CareSource[®] Member:

Your health care is our priority. That is why we are writing to tell you that on March 1, 2018, Humana – CareSource will change its Preferred Drug List (PDL). A PDL is the list of drugs that we prefer your doctor prescribe for you.

As of March 1, 2018, the following medications will be **listed in the Humana – CareSource PDL**.

 Nuelasta OnPro (pegfilgastrim) prefilled syringe with on-body injector (6 mg/0.6 mL) – on medical benefit only

As of March 1, 2018, the following medicines listed in the Humana - CareSource PDL will **require prior authorization.**

- Lidocaine topical (2% gel, 2% solution, 3% cream, 4% cream) prior authorization required if quantity > 1 tube per month
- Lidocaine topical (4% solution, 5% ointment)
- Lidocaine-hydrocortisone topical (0.5%-3% cream)
- Nexium (esomprazole) capsule (20 mg, 40 mg) prescription strengths formulations only
- Prevacid (lansoprazole) capsule (15 mg, 30 mg) prescription strengths formulations only
- Zegerid (omeprazole-sodium bicarbonate) capsule (20-1000 mg and 40-1000 mg) prescription strength formulations only
- Zegerid (omeprazole-sodium bicarbonate) packet (20-1680 mg and 40-1680 mg)

What should you do?

First, talk to your doctor. After February 28, 2018, these drugs will require prior authorization. You and your doctor can find which medicines are preferred in a few different ways:
