



Re: Medicaid Drug List Changes starting January 1, 2026

Dear HAP CareSource Member,

Your health care is our priority. On January 1, 2026, there will be changes to the covered drug list. This includes drugs on the formulary (also called a preferred drug list) and drugs you can get at the doctor's office.

THE FOLLOWING DRUGS HAVE A CHANGE IN STATUS STARTING JANUARY 1, 2026.

Drug Name	Notes
Injection, tofersen, 1 mg (Qalsody)	Prior Authorization Required
Injection, siltuximab, 10 mg (Sylvant)	Prior Authorization Required

What should you do?

First, talk to your doctor. There may be other drugs that you can take instead. There are a few ways you and your doctor can find other drugs covered by your plan:
