



Re: Medicaid Drug List Changes starting January 1, 2026

Dear HAP CareSource Member:

Your health care is our priority. On January 1, 2026, there will be changes to the covered drug list. This includes drugs on the formulary (also called a preferred drug list) and drugs you can get at the doctor's office.

THE FOLLOWING DRUGS WILL BE NON-PREFERRED STARTING JANUARY 1, 2026

Drug Name	Notes
Saxenda (liraglutide)	Moved to Non-Preferred for Anti-Obesity/Weight Loss Agents
Liraglutide (generic for Saxenda)	Moved to Non-Preferred for Anti-Obesity/Weight Loss Agents
Wegovy (semaglutide)	Moved to Non-Preferred for Anti-Obesity/Weight Loss Agents
Zepbound (tirzepatide)	Moved to Non-Preferred for Anti-Obesity/Weight Loss Agents

What should you do?

First, talk to your doctor. There may be other drugs that you can take instead. There are a few ways you and your doctor can find other drugs covered by your plan:
