


## HAP CareSource Clinical Practice Registry



## The Perfect Tool to Streamline Your Practice!

The HAP CareSource Clinical Practice Registry is an online tool available to health partners to identify and prioritize needed health care services, screening, and tests for HAP CareSource members. The Clinical Practice Registry is easy to access via the secure HAP CareSource Provider Portal.

- Identify gaps in care: View preventive service history and easily identify HEDIS® (Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set) gaps in care to discuss during appointments
- **Holistically address patient care:** Receive alerts when HAP CareSource members need tests or screenings, review member appointment histories and view their prescriptions
- Improve clinical outcomes: Easily sort HAP CareSource members into actionable groups for population management



The registry is color-coded, so you can easily identify areas of focus for your patients:

**Green** Indicates **compliance** and provides service date

Indicates service is **past due** and provides most recent service date

lndicates service is needed and provides most recent service date

Not applicable

The registry includes information on, but not limited to, the following quality measures:

## How to Access the HAP CareSource Clinical Practice Registry

- 1. Visit www.CareSource.com/mi/providers/provider-portal/medicaid and follow link to the HAP Provider Portal.
- 2. Enter your HAP username and password, then click the Log In button.
- **3.** Select the HAP CareSource link on the home page to single sign on (SSO) to the HAP CareSource Provider Portal. No registration or separate login is needed.
- **4.** To ensure the security of your data, provide your **multifactor authentication** information.
- 5. Select the **Member Reports** menu on the left to locate the Clinical Practice Registry link. Click on **Clinical Practice Registry** to obtain access.
- **6.** Select the appropriate primary care provider in the **Providers drop-down menu**. The patient data for the members attributed to the selected primary care provider (PCP) will display.

**Note:** Health partners must be registered on the HAP Provider Portal to access the HAP CareSource Provider Portal. <u>Click here</u> to self-register.
