Summary

As outlined in the current Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), Medicaid provider manual, claims to report either a nurse practitioner or physician assistant as the rendering provider are **required** to report a supervising physician.

Impact

Claims submitted without a supervising physician will be denied.

Importance

Per the Medicaid Provider Manual,

- **SUPERVISING PROVIDER** The supervising physician national provider identifier (NPI) may be a professional claim editing requirement for physician services rendered by an enrolled non-physician practitioner, such as a physician's assistant or advanced practice registered nurse. When physician collaboration or supervision is required by State law or Medicaid policy, claims must include the Medicaid-enrolled supervising physician NPI.
- **NURSE PRACTITIONER BILLING AND REIMBURSEMENT** Professional claims must include the NPI of the NP in the Rendering Provider field and the supervising or collaborating physician in the Supervising Provider field as applicable
