## MyCare

We are excited to announce the expansion of MyCare into the remaining 59 counties. New counties will be going live starting April 1st and finishing on August 1st. Sales will begin 60 days prior to the go-live dates; for example, the May 1st rollout will be available for sale on Connecticut starting March 1st. This timeline will be consistently applied for future expansion counties. Thank you for your continued support as we launch these exciting new opportunities!




# Next Generation MyCare Program Rollout Reminder

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) will launch the Next Generation MyCare program on January 1, 2026 to better serve individuals who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid.

The rollout will occur in two phases:

- Phase 1 (January 1, 2026):**  
 Implementation in the 29 counties where the current MyCare Ohio program already operates. These counties are grouped by Area Agency on Aging (AAA) regions, including major areas like Franklin, Cuyahoga, Hamilton, and Summit.
- Phase 2 (April 1, 2026 onward):**  
 Expansion to the remaining counties statewide throughout 2026.



<b>Phase 1: Current MyCare Counties</b>	
On Jan. 1, 2026, ODM will roll out the Next Generation MyCare program in the 29 counties where MyCare is currently available today.
