Summary

As part of our commitment to provide high-quality and cost-effective healthcare, we are implementing a Site of Care Management Program. This program directs administration of select medications to be given in the least intensive setting appropriate for delivery of services and supplies. Our goal is to enhance patient outcomes while managing healthcare costs effectively. The Site of Care Management Program applies to our Marketplace Lines of Business.

What is Site of Care?

A site of care refers to the physical location of infusion or injection administration. Sites of care include hospital outpatient, a provider's office, an ambulatory infusion center or suite, or home-based setting. Many infusions administered in hospitals can be safely managed in other settings without compromising quality.

Why Site of Care Matters

Benefits for Members:

- **Improved Access and Greater Convenience:**
Appointments at alternative sites may offer more flexibility to accommodate members' lifestyles, including options for evenings, weekends and home visits. This flexibility minimizes disruption to work, school, and other responsibilities, while also reducing travel requirements and time commitments. It may also lessen a member's exposure to hospital environments.
- **Enhanced Patient / Member Experience:**
Members often report higher satisfaction when they receive care at alternative sites. Data indicates these settings can provide a more independent, comfortable and less stressful experience. Opportunities for more personalized care and lower infection risks contribute to overall improved patient satisfaction.
- **Lower Out-of-Pocket Costs:**
Alternative sites typically have reduced patient cost-sharing, which can improve adherence to treatment and lead to better health outcomes. Lower costs make it easier for members to access care they need without heavy financial barriers.

Benefits for Providers:

Infusions administered in a hospital setting will not be eligible for reimbursement unless the provider obtains prior approval from CareSource, demonstrating medical necessity criteria are met.
