**Subject:** End of Single Preferred Drug List Legacy Coverage Phase  
**Effective Date:** July 1, 2026

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## Summary

The Nevada Medicaid Single Preferred Drug List (sPDL) Legacy Coverage Phase ends June 30, 2026. Members using non-preferred drug therapies must either switch to a preferred alternative or obtain an approved exception request.

## Impact

As described in [Nevada Medicaid Web Announcement 3787](#), Nevada Medicaid transitioned to a sPDL, effective January 1, 2026. Since then, Nevada Medicaid members have been given a transition period called the Legacy Coverage Phase. The Legacy Coverage Phase allowed Nevada Medicaid members time to transition from a non-preferred product to a preferred product. This Legacy Coverage Phase ends June 30, 2026.

As of July 1, 2026, members who fill a non-preferred product without an approved exception request will receive a rejection at the pharmacy. Members with claims for impacted drugs were mailed a notice of this change.

If a preferred alternative is not appropriate for your patient, you may submit an exception request as a prior authorization. Information on submitting prior authorization requests can be found on [CareSource.com](#).

Addressing therapy changes or exception requests prior to July 1, 2026 can help prevent disruptions in medication access for your patients.
