Subject: ODM Impact Doula Allowable Provider Type/Specialty Combinations

Summary

The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) has made recent system updates to the Provider Network Management (PNM) module that impact doulas who wish to serve pregnant women on Ohio Medicaid but that also provide other types of Medicaid services.

The update allows certain independent provider types who have received a doula certification from the Ohio Board of Nursing to also be able to hold a doula specialty (090) as secondary on their active provider agreement with ODM.

Impact

These already enrolled Medicaid providers now have the ability to perform doula services for pregnant women without forfeiting other lines of their business!

The below list of independent billing provider type and specialty combinations can add the doula specialty (090) as a secondary specialty. This action can be completed in PNM at any time. For assistance on how to add a doula specialty, refer to the *Updating or Adding a Specialty* resource found under the [Learning](#) tab in PNM. Providers will need to attach their doula certification from BON when completing this request in PNM.

Allowable Provider Type/Specialty Combinations:

- 07 – Registered Dietician Nutritionist
- 25 / 250 – Non-agency Personal Care Aide
- 26 / 260 – Non-agency Home Care Attendant
- 37 / 370 – Licensed Independent Social Worker
- 38 – Non-agency Nurse – RN or LPN (380, 381, 382, and 383)
- 47 / 474 – Clinical Counseling
- 52 / 520 – Marriage and Family Therapy
- 54 / 540 – Chemical Dependency
- 55 – Waivered Services Individual (456, 455, 454, 453, 451, and 45A)
- 71 – Nurse Midwife Individual
- 72 – Nurse Practitioner Individual
