Your health care is our priority. That is why we are writing to tell you that on July 1, 2021, CareSource will change its Preferred Drug List (PDL). A PDL is a list of preferred drugs.

THE FOLLOWING MEDICINES HAVE A CHANGE IN STATUS EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021.

Brand Name	Generic Name	Dose(s)	Notes
Differin Gel	Adapalene Gel	0.1%	Generic moves to preferred with no prior authorization required for members under 24 years old. Prior authorization required for members 24 years and older.
Nuvigil	Armodafinil	50mg, 150mg, 200mg, 250mg	Moves to preferred with no prior authorization required
Provigil	Modafinil	100mg, 200mg	Moves to preferred with no prior authorization required
Tazorac Cream, Gel	Tazarotene Cream, Gel	0.05%, 0.1%	Moves to non-preferred

What should you do?

First, talk to your prescriber. There may be other medicines on the CareSource PDL that you can take instead. There are a few ways you and your prescriber can find medicines:
