## **Summary**

The Ohio Department of Medicaid selected CareSource to offer a combined Medicare and Medicaid plan, <u>CareSource® MyCare Ohio (HMO D-SNP)</u>. This plan is a part of the new Next Generation MyCare Ohio program, beginning January 1, 2026.

### **Impact**

As part of the transition to the Next Generation MyCare program, CareSource will no longer offer an Ohio CareSource Dual Advantage plan as of December 31, 2025. The CareSource MyCare Ohio (HMO D-SNP) plan replaces the Medicare-Medicaid Plan program, which ends December 31, 2025.

Current CareSource® MyCare Ohio (Medicare-Medicaid Plan) and CareSource Dual Advantage™ (HMO D-SNP) enrollees are being automatically moved into CareSource MyCare Ohio (HMO D-SNP) with no break in coverage.

#### **Importance**

- The plan is a fully integrated dual eligible special needs plan.
- The plan is a type of Medicare Advantage plan designed for individuals who are eligible for both Medicare and full Medicaid benefits (dual eligibles).
- It includes Medicaid benefits, including Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS) and behavioral health services, that are integrated with Medicare benefits, aiming for better care coordination. Learn more about the benefit offerings.

#### **Going Statewide**

The Next Generation MyCare program will roll out in a phased approach to ensure a smooth transition for both members and providers. Starting January 1, 2026, our CareSource MyCare Ohio (HMO D-SNP) plan will be available in the 29 counties where MyCare is currently available. From April 1, 2026, through August 1, 2026, the program will expand to remaining counties until coverage is offered statewide.
