Death rates due to drug overdose continue to climb at alarming rates. CareSource® supports state-wide efforts to combat drug use. We encourage the **use of naloxone** following opiate overdose by loved ones and first responders.

- ✓ Know the signs of an overdose
- ✓ Call 9-1-1
- ✓ Administer naloxone
- ✓ Perform rescue breathing
- ✓ Read about Project Dawn (www.healthy.ohio.gov/vipp/drug/ProjectDAWN.aspx)

Prescriptions made easy for members or loved ones (no prior authorization)

- Naloxone HCl 1mg/ml 2ml prefilled Luer-Lock Needleless Syringe; Qty = 2
- Intranasal Mucosal Atomizing Device; Qty = 2

After administration, seek emergency medical care.

Billing codes for medical benefit (no prior authorization)

- Naloxone injection J2310 / Atomizing device S8100 with modifier KX
