Subject: Primary Care Rate Increase (PCRI)/Adjusted Rate Ending

As part of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA), the PCRI, or adjusted rate, ended on Dec. 31, 2014. The federal government no longer finances the difference between the state Medicaid payment rate and the applicable Medicare rate. Primary care physicians who can attest that they satisfy specific eligibility criteria are eligible to receive increased Medicaid payments for services provided to individuals eligible for Medicaid during the 2013 and 2014 calendar years.

To receive payment inclusive of the rate increase, all eligible claims for the adjusted rate must be received by Humana – CareSource no later than June 30, 2015.

Claims received after June 30, 2015, for services rendered to individuals eligible for Medicaid during 2013 and 2014 will not be eligible for the adjusted rate payment.
