

## Montgomery County Care Pharmacy Benefits

Beginning May 2, 2011, Montgomery County Care members will be able to obtain certain insulin, diabetic supplies and asthma medications through the program when prescribed by primary care providers of the Community Health Centers of Greater Dayton.
