Supported Wright State University's "Take Flight" Program; a program that provides wraparound supports to help reduce the financial burden for economically challenged, racially diverse students.

Supported Sinclair Community College's TartanTOPS program. The Tartan TOPS (Transition Option in Post-Secondary Education) provides a career/educational pathway for students with intellectual disabilities (such as autism, Down's Syndrome, etc.). These are generally students whose disability is substantial enough to prevent them from pursuing traditional educational opportunities, but not severe enough to warrant significant care.

Ascension St. Vincent Foundation – Indiana

- Program Title: Peyton Manning Children's Hospital at Ascension St.
 Vincent Pediatric Nurse Navigation Program
- Overview: The new Pediatric Nurse Navigation Program will create a single point of contact for families of pediatric patients who need help navigating the complicated healthcare system, especially children who are facing complex and/or chronic conditions. It will better facilitate uninterrupted care by working with families to reduce delays in treatment, streamline care, avoid hospital readmissions, and improve communication with clinicians and care teams. The Pediatric Nurse Navigators will also be instrumental in reducing the stress and anxiety frequently associated with the healthcare experience by meeting the developmental, psychosocial, and emotional needs of patients and families.
- "From the first day I talked to her, (Anita, PMCH Pediatric Nurse Navigator) she has been nothing but supportive. She's helped a lot with mix-ups at the pharmacy and trying to get my son the medications he needs. Sometimes it's so confusing about what appointments are when, so she has been able to help with that too. She breaks down the doctor's big words to a parent level and helps me understand what is going on. When I first met her I broke and cried. I was just at a loss of what to dobut working with Anita gives me hope!"

Appalachian Children Coalition – Ohio

- Program Title: Appalachian Children Coalition Expansion
- Overview: The grant from CareSource will support the development of school health centers delivering primary care and behavioral health services, prevention programs focused on teen suicide and other prevalent issues, ongoing work to encourage individuals to pursue behavioral health careers in the region, and relevant research on best-practice models to address behavioral health challenges.
